

Indicators Vehicle Purchase & Modifications Level 2 Credential

Occupational Therapists assessing at this level may assess people who may require:

- 1. Pedal modifications such as a left foot accelerator to drive a vehicle safely; and/or
- 2. Modification to secondary controls including switches, knobs, levers, indicators, park brake and ignition to drive a vehicle safely and/or
- 3. Hand controls; and/or
- 4. A cognitive function assessment to determine safety to drive; or
- 5. An on road assessment to determine safety to drive

Option module (Drive from wheelchair or joystick technology) allows Occupational Therapists assessing at this level to assess people who may require:

- 6. A ramp hoist or other vehicle adaptation in order to access the vehicle while seated in a wheelchair for the purposes of driving whilst seated in a wheelchair; or
- 7. A wheelchair docking system to achieve safe driving from the wheelchair; or
- 8. A swing away back support for the purposes of driving from the wheelchair, or
- 9. Custom lateral supports to achieve safe driving from the wheelchair or
- 10. Joystick technology to achieve safe driving.
